Directions for Worm Tests

- 1. Print contact information CLEARLY on the adjacent Laboratory Request form. We must be able to read your information to process the test.
- 2. Label the provided zip-lock bags with your pet's name.
- 3. Place 1-2 tsp of fecal matter collected within the last 24 hours into one of the small zip-lock bags and seal.
- 4. Place that bag into the 2nd zip-lock bag and seal.
- 5. Place the small bags into the large bag and seal.
- 6. Place the large bag AND this entire original 3-page form into the envelope.
- 7. Apply postage and press flat so that the package will pass through postage machines.
 - The post office will not handle and packages that are not securely sealed and dry. There is a \$10 charge to re-send the forms if they are not properly sealed and legible.

- You may send multiple samples inside a larger mailer to save money, but you must provide an original 3-page completed form for each sample.
